




NEWSLETTER OCTOBER 2021

40th anniversary



Exactly 40 years ago, the history of 'minette' mining in Luxembourg came to an end. On the 27 November 1981, the Thillenberg mine, the last iron ore mine in the country, was closed down.

Historian Denis Klein from the «Musée National des Mines de Fer» in Rumelange looks back on the history of iron ore in Luxembourg. He explains the beginnings, the peak and the end of open-cast mining, as well as the mines in the 1970s and 1980s.
