When in 1997 the last blast furnace in the Minett region was shut down, the future prospects for the region were not the best. It was necessary to look for solutions at regional level. This is how the inter-

municipal syndicate PRO-SUD came into being in 2003.

Thanks to coherent regional cooperation, southern Luxembourg was able to join the UNESCO World Network of Biosphere Reserves in 2020. After 20 years of close cooperation, the region is preparing

to take up its next challenge: the reduction of greenhouse gas emissions in order to achieve carbon neutrality as quickly as possible.

This is one of the topics of this newsletter. Another area in which we are involved as Minett UNESCO Biosphere is the promotion of local food products. This includes fresh fruit from local orchards. These orchards are now uniformly marked. You will find more information about this project in this newsletter.






